Scope of Work:

Clough completed a contract for ROIC (Real Offshore Installation Company Sdn. Bhd) of Malaysia for the installation of 2.24 kilometres of 24 inch dry gas export pipeline and associated stalk-on riser within the B17 field development.

The pipeline was installed between the Muda Process Platform (MDPP) and the existing 42 inch 3rd PTT trunkline, located in 60 metres water depth.

The B17 field development, which is in the offshore Joint Development Area (JDA) between Malaysia and Thailand, is operated by CARIGALI-PTTEPI Operating Company Sdn. Bhd. (CPOC).

This was the first commitment for the *Java Constructor* following its upgrade.

The *Java Constructor* commenced mobilisation on 19 May 2009 and arrived back in Singapore on 24 June 2009.
