Scope of Work:

NuCoastal (Thailand) Limited awarded Clough Thailand Limited (CTL) a contract to undertake fabrication of a wellhead and process platform for the Songkhla Field Development Project. The Songkhla basin is located in the south western portion of the Gulf of Thailand and is the first field to be developed by Coastal Energy Company in the region.

Scope of work included engineering, shop detailing, procurement, fabrication, assembly, pre-commissioning, loadout and sea fastening of one wellhead platform and production platform connected by a bridge link. The two platforms comprise a subsea structure, mid span brace, deck, and with piles fabrication and appurtenances having a combined weight of approximately 2,500 tonnes.

The structural design of the platforms was performed by UWG of the UK and fabrication work completed at Clough's fabrication facility in Sattahip, located on the eastern seaboard of the Gulf of Thailand.
